### Location

Thanks to its central location, the SEEDAMM PLAZA is easily reached by all means of transportation. It is located in the middle of the economic region of Zurich, at the very beginning of Lake Zurich.

### Arrival by train

Starting from the Zurich main train station the trip is reduced to 30 minutes. From the train station Pfäffikon SZ the hotel can easily be reached in 10 walking minutes. You can also use the public bus to the stop «Schweizerhof» and then reach us by foot in 2 to 3 minutes. Using «Seedamm Taxi» you can reach the SEEDAMM PLAZA in 5 minutes from the train station Pfäffikon SZ.
