



RESEARCH PRIZE OF THE SWISS SOCIETY OF CARDIOLOGY

Rules for Entry

- 1 The Research Prize of the Swiss Society of Cardiology is awarded for original research work in cardiovascular disease.
- 2 Prizes may be awarded for one or more research projects (to a maximum of three) provided that they are connected.
- 3 The manuscripts should be published or accepted for publication in a recognized peer-reviewed journal. Consideration can be given only to work published in the year in which the prize is awarded or in the year immediately preceding it.
- 4 Applicants should be the principal author of the work being submitted. Should several works be submitted, the applicant should be the principal author of at least one of them.
- 5 Applicants must be under 40 years of age on the deadline for submission. They must be Swiss citizens or working in Switzerland at the time of the award. The submitted research work must have been conducted in Switzerland. Swiss citizens may also submit work carried out abroad.
- 6 The prize will be awarded annually by the Swiss Society of Cardiology together with Amgen Switzerland AG, normally at the Annual Conference, but exceptionally at another event sponsored by the Society.
- 7 The prize winner will be selected by a prize jury whose members will be nominated by the board of the Swiss Society of Cardiology. The jury consists of a chairman, representatives of the Swiss universities (Basel, Berne, Fribourg, Geneva, Lausanne, Lugano, Luzern, St. Gallen, Zurich), as well as representatives of the board of the Swiss Society of Cardiology. Members of the jury will be elected for four years and may be re-elected.
- 8 The prize will be CHF 30'000, donated by Amgen Switzerland AG.
- 9 The prize winner undertakes to use the prize money of CHF 30'000 exclusively to continue his or her research in Switzerland. The money may be used for salaries, equipment or disposable materials.
- 10 A person can receive this prize only once.

Applications should contain at minimum a short CV and the submitted manuscripts as PDF.
