



## OTTO HESS TRAINEE AWARD OF THE SWISS SOCIETY OF CARDIOLOGY

### Rules for Entry

1. The *Otto Hess Trainee Award* aims to recognize and support young trainees in cardiology who are actively engaged in cardiovascular research at an early stage of their careers.
2. Each year approx. 3 trainees are awarded CHF 5'000.- each. The award is funded by the *Swiss Society of Cardiology* and granted by the board of the *Swiss Society of Cardiology*. A person can receive this award only once.
3. The prize money is to be used for the winner's personal research activities. Eligible uses are research project equipment or disposables, expenses for results presentations at scientific meetings or congresses, training visits in other research institutions, or participation in postgraduate courses in the field of the prize winners research interests. The awardee must use the grant within 2 years.
4. Applicants must be  $\leq 32$  years of age at the submission deadline. The applicant must be in cardiology training or subspecialty training in pediatric cardiology at an SIWF-accredited institution for specialty training in cardiology or for subspecialty training in pediatric cardiology or enrolled to study human medicine at the deadline of submission.
5. Eligible for submission are master and doctoral theses, full-length publications in a peer-reviewed journal, or presentations at international congresses of the ESC, ACC, AHA or WCC\*\* or working groups thereof. The applicant must be (co-)first author of the submitted work. The submitted research work must have been conducted in Switzerland. The work must be published/presented or accepted for publication/presentation in the same year of submission or in the year immediately preceding it. The date of acceptance by the medical faculty applies to theses.
6. Applications should include the following documents: a) short CV; b) thesis, publication, or abstract to be considered (if applicable with letter of acceptance); c) Letter of support by a SIWF-accredited\* institution for training in (pediatric) cardiology. The application documents should include information about all relevant rules of entry.
7. The awardee(s) will be selected by the *Otto Hess Trainee Award* Jury. The award jury typically consists of 9 representatives from the Swiss university hospitals (Basel, Bern, Geneva, Lausanne, Zurich), other Swiss hospitals with research activities in cardiology and at least 1 representative of the board of the *Swiss Society of Cardiology*. The jury members are elected for 4 years by the board of the *Swiss Society of Cardiology* and may be re-elected.
8. The award will typically be awarded during the annual meeting of the *Swiss Society of Cardiology*.
